Are you ready for the big event! We are ticking down the minutes until we get to serve our community at the first Recycle Roundup of 2026.

At no-direct cost, you, our residents and landowners, can recycle and safely dispose items:

- Household Hazardous Waste (HHW) – household chemicals, oil-based paint, batteries, lightbulbs, and more!
- Foam (polystyrene, Styrofoam™) – watch our [video](#) for acceptable items.
- Electronics
- Tires ! Only tires need to be pre-registered.

! Bring proof of residency (ID, license) or landownership (tax bill)

! Pre-registration optional for all, but registration is required for tire recycling at least two-days in advance

How We Celebrated Earth Day and Arbor Day!

All of us at the Van Buren Conservation District hope you all had an amazing Earth Day and Arbor Day celebrating conservation and our planet this past month! The VBCD started our month with our big annual spring event, the Tree Sale! As always it was a massive hit this year.

With your help, we were able to distribute over 13,000 trees to local landowners, helping to make more habitat for wildlife in southwestern Michigan. That's a huge number, so thank you for helping us with that reforestation work!

Twelve awesome volunteers joined us to wrap tree seedlings and put the pre-orders together, and we couldn't have done it without them!

The VBCD was also able to get out into the community in April to share knowledge and participate in some great community events. VBCD staff spent a lot of time talking to residents to get them excited about nature and their own backyards.

VBCD team member Kalli Marshall participated at the South Haven Area Chamber of Commerce Young Professionals community cleanup Together with other organizations and volunteers over 560 pounds of trash and junk

VBCD's Jena Johnson also recently gave an important and well-attended presentation at the Liberty Hyde Bailey Museum. During her presentation, she focused on six well-known invasive plant species currently being sold at greenhouses and nurseries across Michigan that might soon be banned for sale. These plants include the aggressive Callery Pear, Water Lettuce, and Japanese Barberry.

Another one of our teammates, Emily Hickmott, got to spend an afternoon with the after-school program - Van Buren Youth Initiative in Lawrence to talk "Careers in Conservation". They paired an overview of the VBCD's work with a walk in the woods to see how utilizing field guides can be a fun way to learn more about what is around us.
