

CDBG Homeowner Improvement Program



What is CDBG?

The CDBG Homeowner Improvement Program is a grant program that provides low income homeowners with up to \$20,000 for necessary safety, accessibility, and energy efficiency updates to their home.

Who qualifies for the program?

- Earn 80% or less of the area median income (AMI)
- Have owned your home for at least one year
- Occupy the home as your primary residence
- Be current on all taxes
- Have lawful residence in the US

What repairs are eligible?

- Roof Replacement or Repair
- Concrete, Asphalt, and Masonry Replacement or Repair
- Handrail Installation
- Electrical Repairs
- Furnace and/or Air Conditioner Replacement or Repairs
- Tuck-pointing
- Water Heater Replacement
- Insulation
- Foundation repairs (crack repairs, leaks, sump pump installation, etc.)
- Retaining Walls
- Accessibility modifications
- Window and door replacement
- Porches
- Interior walls and ceilings
- Waterproofing
